

Van Dyck Antwerp holiday prize draw: Terms and Conditions

1. This prize draw is open to residents of the UK, Channel Islands and Isle of Man aged 18 years or more, excluding employees of the Art Fund and the National Portrait Gallery, or anyone else connected with this promotion (or members of their families).
